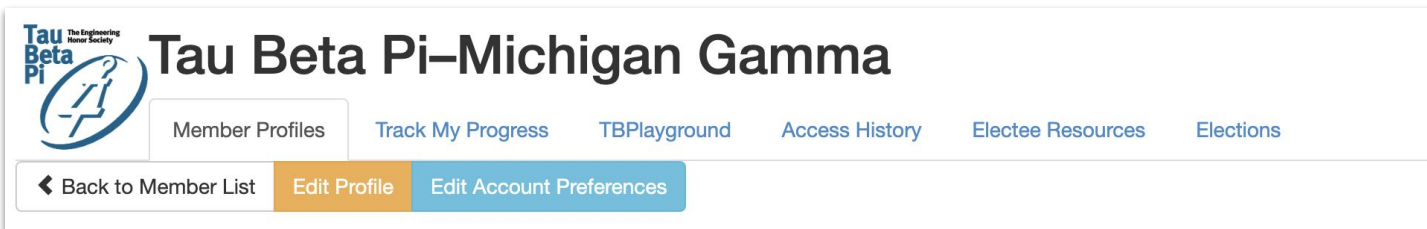


Event Sign-Up
