- Note that the active requirements are different from electee requirements!



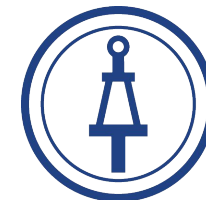

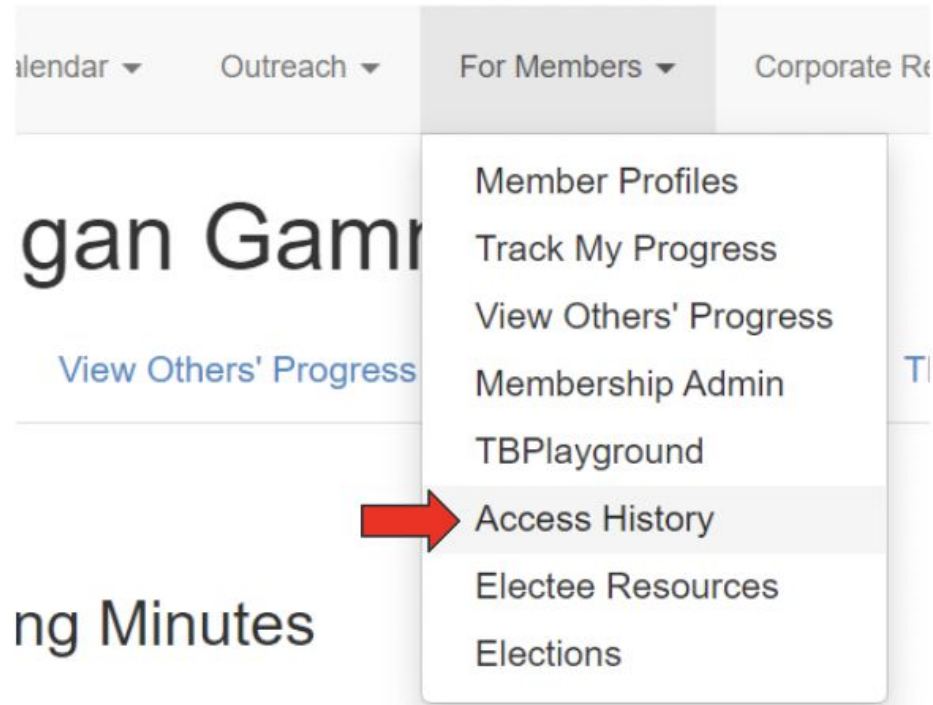
PROCEDURE FOR FOOD SIGNUPS

CONVENTION

The Convention serves as:

1. The supreme governing body of Tau Beta Pi conducting the business of the Association. In this sense, it is the annual stockholders' meeting of the corporation. The Convention alone has the power to grant new chapters, elect an Executive Council, and amend the Constitution (subject to chapter ratification) and the Bylaws.
2. A training session for student delegates, most of whom are chapter presidents who will serve this year. The Chapter Development Program, including Interactive Chapter Exchange (ICE) and District meetings, is designed to achieve this goal.
3. An opportunity for delegates from all parts of the country to meet and socialize with each other. Chapter representatives are afforded an opportunity to meet with Association Officials and to learn first-hand about problems, solutions, and opinions on the role of TBP on the nation's campuses.

Last year's Convention was hosted by South Dakota School of Mines & Technology in Rapid City, South Dakota.

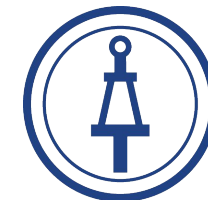

What happens at Convention?

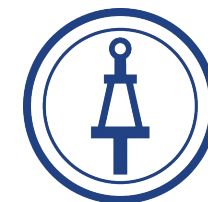
- Delegates are assigned to committees to handle Convention business that has been prepared throughout the preceding year.
- Committees are not restricted to the business presented to them but typically stick to what they are asked to work on.
- Our voting delegate (Hunter) was assigned to the Constitution and Bylaws Committee
- This committee is responsible for reviewing and recommending action on proposals related to the National Constitution and Bylaws



Constitution and Bylaws Committee

Charges:

- Review and recommend action a policy developed by the Executive Council from the old Constitution and Bylaws.
- Review a proposal to amend the Constitution to permit Executive Council responsibilities to be defined in policy.
- Review a proposal to amend Articles V and VII based on the work of the General Revision Phase 2 Task Force.
- Consider requests for review arising from other committees during the Convention.



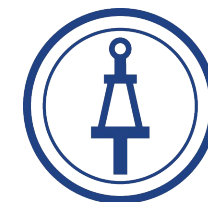

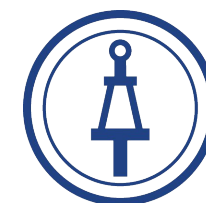
- We would love to take some non-officer actives as well to future conventions!

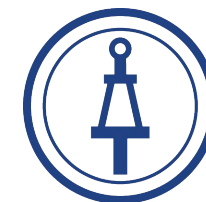

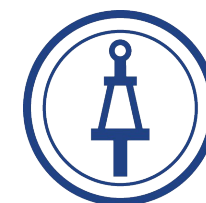

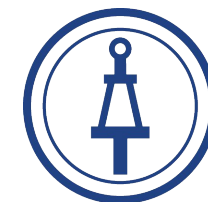
