ONLY HONOR SOCIETY REPRESENTING THE ENTIRE ENGINEERING PROFESSION


- •Founded in 1885 at Lehigh University





INITIATION REQUIREMENTS

THE BASICS

- There are two types of members in Tau Beta Pi:
 - Actives: Initiated members of the organization
 - Electees: Members in the process of joining (i.e. you!)
- The "electing process" comprises the steps you must take this semester in order to become a life-long member of Tau Beta Pi.
- Throughout this electing process, your VP will be your greatest resource and go-to point of contact (that's me!).



ELECTEE REQUIREMENTS

- Attendance at all (5) General meetings, Elections, and Initiation
- Completion of 16 total hours of service
- Attendance at 2 Professional Development (PD) and 2 Social events
- Attendance at 3 meetings of your Electee Team
- Participation in TBPals (1 meeting get coffee, etc)
- Character evaluation process
- Peer Interviews
- Electee Exam
- Initiation Fee (\$100)



MEETING ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Most meetings are on Tuesdays at 6:30 PM
 - First General (Jan 21st or Jan 24th) (**You're here right now!**)
 - 4 more General Meetings + Elections
 - New Initiatives optional
- 3 electee team meetings
- Initiation and Banquet Apr 19th (3-9 PM)
- If you cannot make any of these dates, please let me know and we can work something out!



INITIATION & BANQUET

- Initiation will be held on Saturday, April 19th in 1500 EECS at 3:00 p.m.
 - If you know you will be unable to make it, please reach out to me (Paco) and we can make alternate arrangements.
 - This is when you will officially be inducted into the chapter.
- Initiation is followed up with our semesterly banquet
 - Attendance at this banquet is not enforced like Initiation is but it is HIGHLY encouraged that you attend.
 - This will be a celebration of your election into the chapter so come celebrate with your fellow electees!



HOURS REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of <u>16 total hours of service</u>
 - 1 hour Tutoring
 - 4 hours of K-12 Outreach events
 - 11 hours from other events





HOURS REQUIREMENTS

- Attendance at <u>4 total PD/Social Events</u>
 - 2 PD events
 - Corporate info sessions, resume reviews, etc
 - 2 social events
 - Game nights, BWW socials, boba socials, Cantina nights, and more!



CHARACTER EVALUATION

- Completion of Electee Questionnaire + Resume upload
 - Due by Monday, February 3rd
 - Can only be done after making a website profile at tbpmig.org
- Completion of in-person Character Interview with TBP actives
 Will be held February 5th 7th, 9 am 5pm

 - 25 minutes long
 - Sign-up is on the website (tbpmig.org)



PAPERWORK & DUES

- Completion of "Electee Exam" by April 15th
 - Exam is in your folder already! Also available online
 - Don't take it too seriously! (Work with your electee team + reach out to actives/officers)
- Completion of 6 Casual Peer Interviews by April 15th
 - Interview fellow electees and actives to get to know one another
 - Ask creative questions! No favorite colors!
 - Also meant to be fun, like the exam! (don't take it too seriously)
- Payment of \$100 one-time Membership Fee by April 15th
 - Covers your national membership, personal engraved Bent, etc.
 - Reach out to me or our treasurer (Jaccob Bell) if this poses any financial burden




