
SWE/TBP Career Fair

INTERVIEW STRUCTURE

• 30-minute time slots for 25-minute interviews

Before

- Sign up for a slot on our website
- Review the electee's questionnaire response

Minutes 0 ~ 10

- Introduce yourself + Get to know the electee
- First section of the electee questionnaire

Minutes 10 ~ 25

- Short answers + Long essay in the electee questionnaire
- Extra questions about "exemplary character"

After

- Fill out the evaluation form on our website
- Must conduct at least 1 interview for DA/PA



INTERVIEW PREP

- You will have access to an electee's questionnaire response once you sign up for an interview with the electee.
- For Members → Access History → View Electee Questionnaire Responses
- Dress Code = Business Casual (for everyone)
- You will receive a reminder with more info before the interview.
 - Instructions for navigating our website



INTERVIEW TIPS

Friendly and gentle questioning or encouragement is effective!

- Be nice to electees.
- Remind them that the interview is not supposed to be scary.

Do not get caught up on sticking to the "schedule"!

• Focus on learning about an electee, not following the outline.

Stay professional!

• We are an honor society, after all.

ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER

•Interrupt:

- Point of order
 - The chair is doing something procedurally wrong
- Point of personal privilege
 - Text on the screen is too small, Speaker is too quiet

Speak before others waiting:

- Point of information
 - Factual question, Current state of debate
- Point of parliamentary inquiry
 - Would an amendment be in order? What magic words should I say?

PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENTS

Section I

"General Body"

I.4 Officer Corps

a.iii.3)

May only last for two academic terms, after which time they must be approved by the chapter membership general body. This can be either as a permanent officer position, or as an extension of the ad hoc position. An extension of the ad hoc position requires a simple majority vote of the general body, and may not be for longer than another two terms. An officer position may not exist in an ad hoc state for more than four consecutive terms. Any ad hoc position that has existed for four consecutive terms cannot be recreated as ad hoc without a gap of at least two terms.

I.5 Committees

c.iv)

May exist for a maximum of two years, after which time they must be approved by the chapter membership general body. This can be either as a permanent committee, or as an extension of the ad hoc committee. An extension of the ad hoc committee requires a simple majority vote of the general body, and may not be for longer than another year. A committee may not exist as ad hoc for more than three years. Any ad hoc committee that has existed for three years cannot be recreated as ad hoc without a gap of at least one year
