GOOD INTERVIEWING PRACTICES



Tips for having an informative and pleasant interview

Friendliness and gentle questioning/encouragement is effective!

Don't get caught up on sticking to the "schedule"

Provide the correct materials to the electee

Stay professional (watch your body language)

More about how they think, less about the answer

Be honest, share any concerns, and explain them
