- We are going on a picnic together, each person is bringing something that starts with the same letter as your name
- Each person will introduce themselves with their item, ie.
 - 1st person: I'm Josh and I'm bringing Jello

Picto-Draw

How to play:

- Everyone has a stack of paper
 - # of papers = # of team members
- First person writes a phrase or sentence
 - Passes stack to left, sentence on top
- Second person reads, then places sentence on bottom of stack (face up)
 - Second person draws image of phrase on NEW paper
 - Passes stack to left, drawing on top
- Third person sees drawing, then places drawing on bottom of stack (face up)
 - Third person writes phrase on top paper describing image
 - Passes stack to left, on and on
