

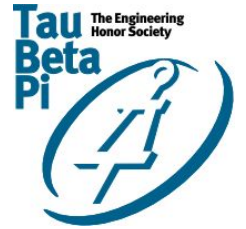

# ELECTIONS

## Confidentiality

- All discussion during elections is confidential and is not to be repeated outside this room

# ELECTIONS

## Election Order

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Grad Vice President
4. Treasurer
5. Any other officers
  - a. Team Leads must be voted on before officers on that team

\*\*\* Incoming and Outgoing Presidents may not participate in discussion of candidates.

\*\*\* Incoming Team Leads may not participate in discussion of officers on their team

# ELECTIONS

## Speech/Questions Time Limits

- President, VP, GVP, Treasurer = 5 minutes
  - 3 minutes for speech
- Team Leads (Service Coord. & Chapter Dev.) = 3.5 minutes
  - 2 minutes for speech
- Advisors = 1.5 minutes
- Everyone Else = 2.5 minutes
  - 1.5 minutes for speech

\*\*\* Limits can be extended by motion from the floor, must affect all candidates equally

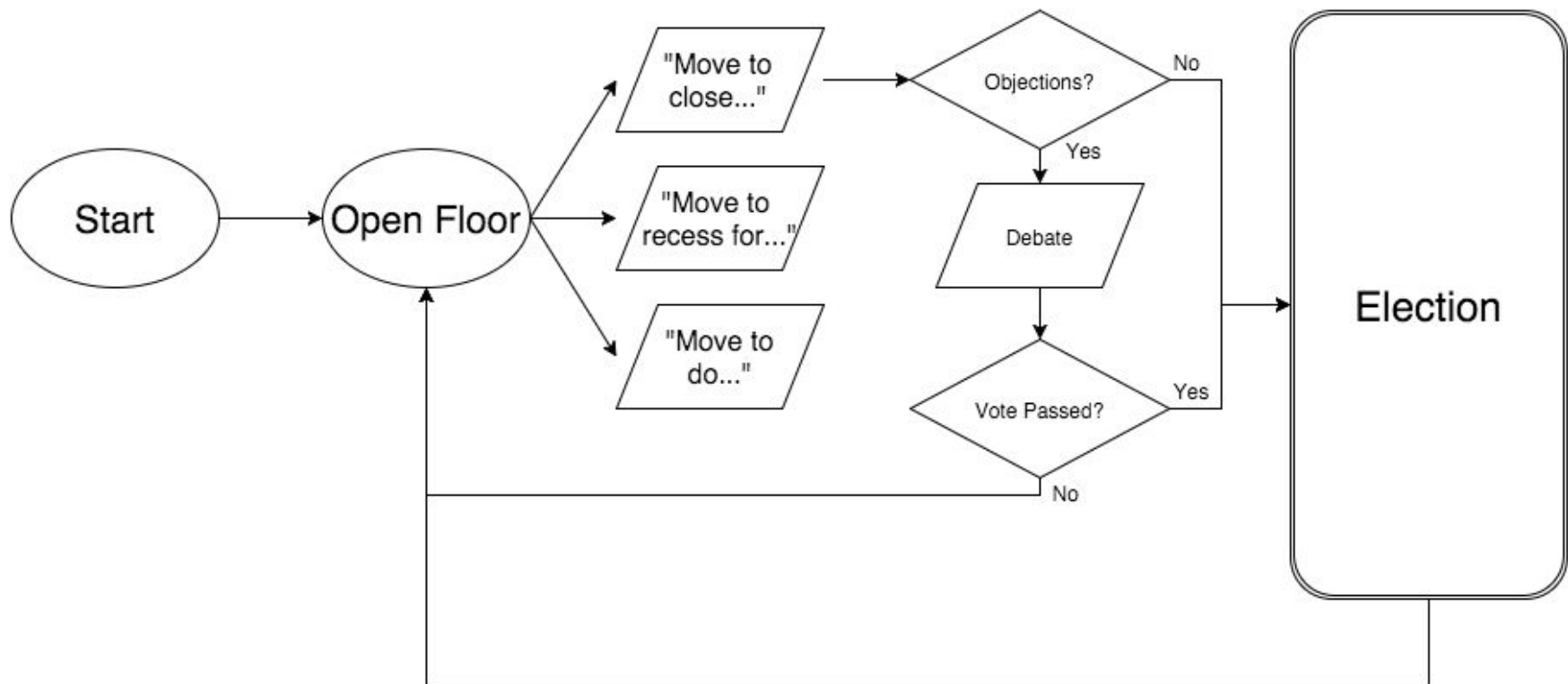
# ELECTIONS

## No-Confidence and Voice Votes

- To win an election:
  - For advisor, must receive a majority of the votes
  - For all other positions, must receive a plurality of the votes
  - Failure to do so is a vote of no-confidence
- Voice Votes
  - Uncontested elections will be voted on by voice vote (no Zoom Poll unless division is called)

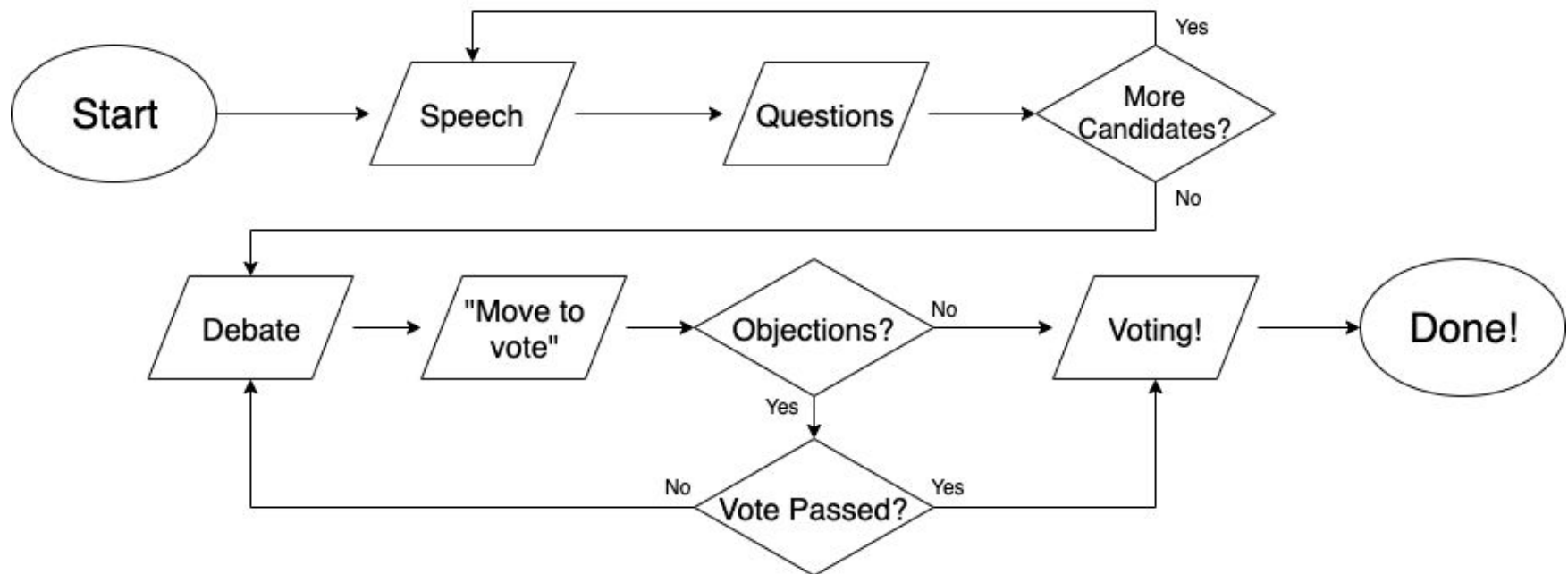

## Other Zoom Voting Logistics

- Waiting Room:
  - Candidates for a position in consideration will be moved to waiting room
  - Late arrivals-- in waiting room until current position being elected closes
- Discussions:
  - Use the “raise hand” feature to be recognized to speak.
- Voting:
  - Poll results are anonymous and the vote breakdown will not be shared, only the result.
  - Benson and Kyle are the designated “Poll-watchers”
