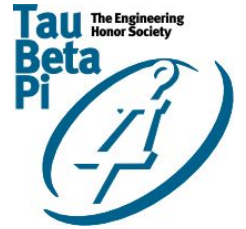

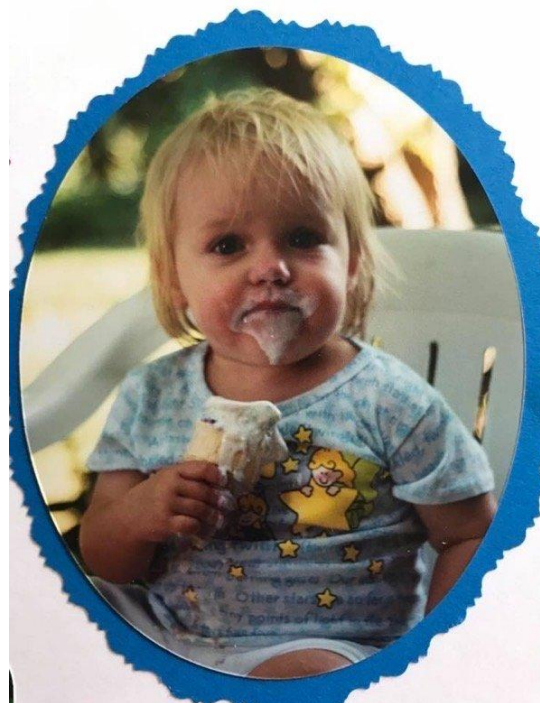

Elections Procedure

ELECTIONS

Confidentiality

- Only initiated TBP members and electees for the current semester are allowed in the room
- All discussion during elections is confidential and is not to be repeated outside this room

ELECTIONS

Election Order

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Grad Vice President
4. Treasurer
5. Any other officers
 - a. Team Leads must be voted on before officers on that team

*** Incoming and Outgoing Presidents may not participate in discussion of candidates.

*** Incoming Team Leads may not participate in discussion of officers on their team

ELECTIONS

Speech/Questions Time Limits

- President, VP, GVP, Treasurer = 5 minutes
 - 3 minutes for speech
- Team Leads (Service Coord. & Chapter Dev.) = 3.5 minutes
 - 2 minutes for speech
- Advisors = 1.5 minutes
- Everyone Else = 2.5 minutes
 - 1.5 minutes for speech

*** Limits can be extended by motion from the floor, must affect all candidates equally

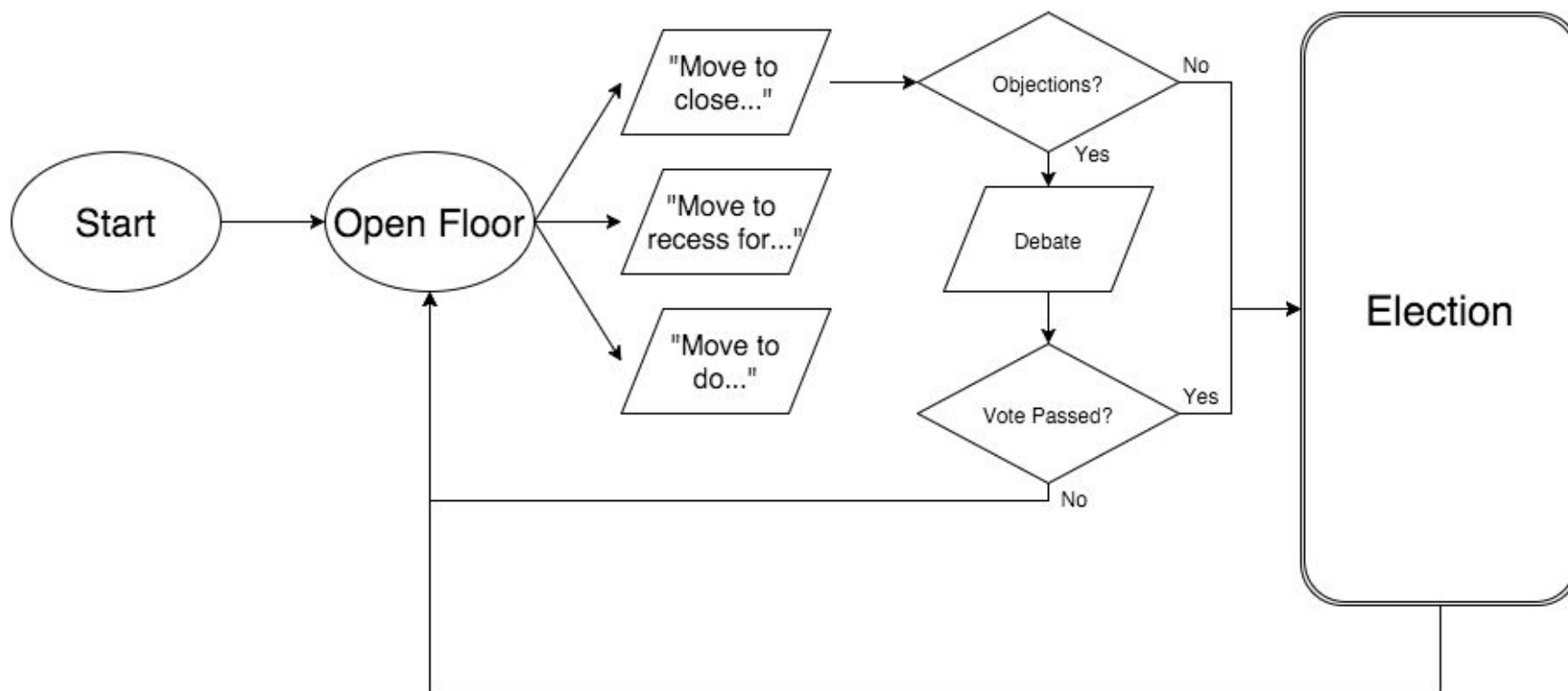
ELECTIONS

No-Confidence and Voice Votes

- To win an election:
 - For advisor, must receive a majority of the votes
 - For all other positions, must receive a plurality of the votes
 - Failure to do so is a vote of no-confidence
- Voice Votes
 - Uncontested elections will be voted on by voice vote (no iClickers unless division is called)

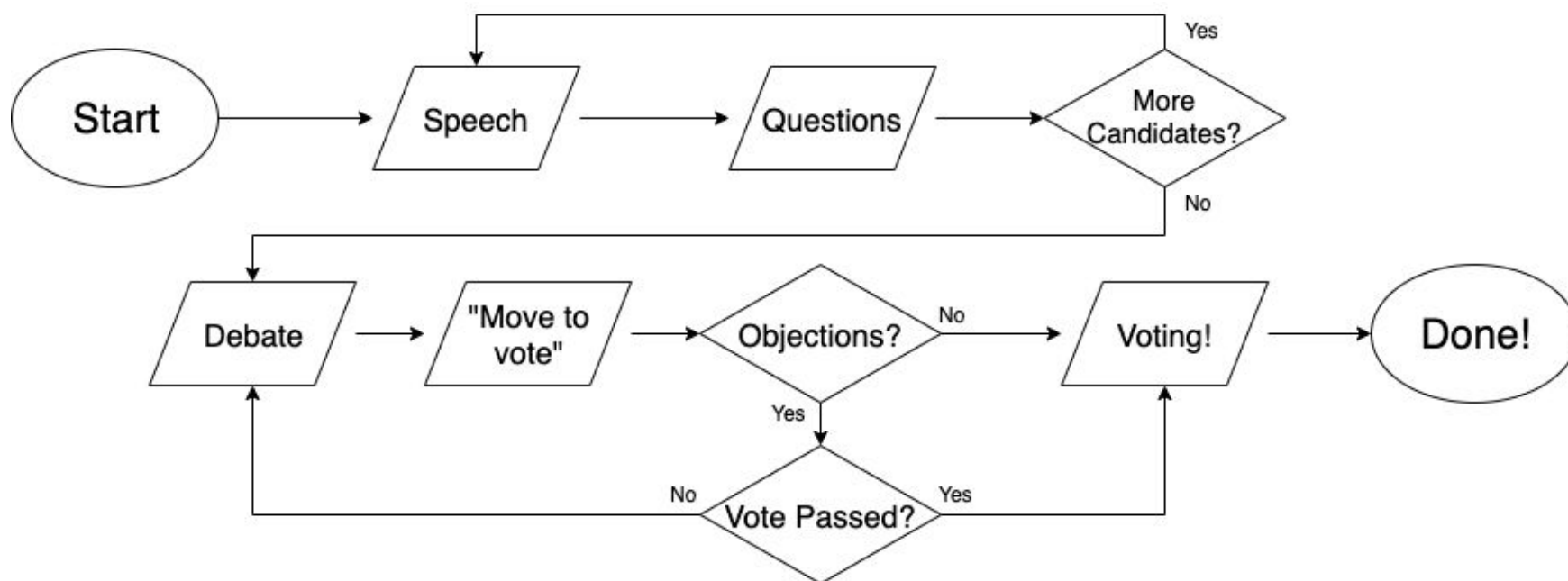

VOTING

i-Clicker Setup

We will be using i-Clickers to vote today.

Kyle will be running the voting system.

Test Vote time!

For all votes today:

A - YES

B - NO

When Kyle says “Go!” cast your vote:

Is Blue > Maize?

Bingo Rules

You must shout “Bingo!”, but only when it won’t be disruptive.

You must not ask silly questions just to get someone (including yourself) to say something particular.

You are permitted to ask questions that are **useful and informative** in the hopes that a particular phrase is said in the answer.

Validity of questions is determined by the chair, who can rule any such questions as dilatory, and then Kyle will frown in your general direction.

Bingo Rules, Part 2

There will be prizes, awarded according to the hallowed principle of first-come-first-serve.

You may not get more than two Bingos. Do not pass Go, do not collect \$200.

Kyle has the final authority to assess subjective phrases/actions.
