Publicity (one semester)

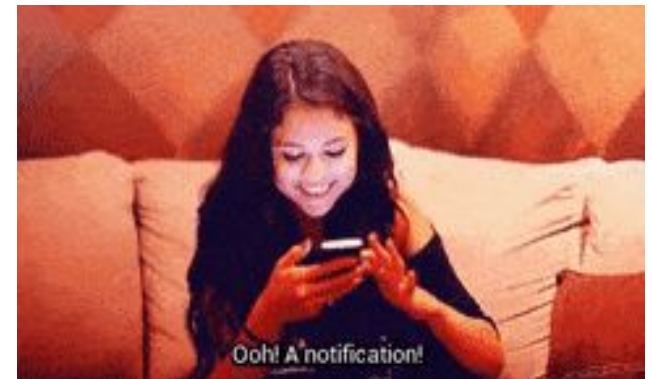
Responsibilities:

Skills: Familiarity with social media



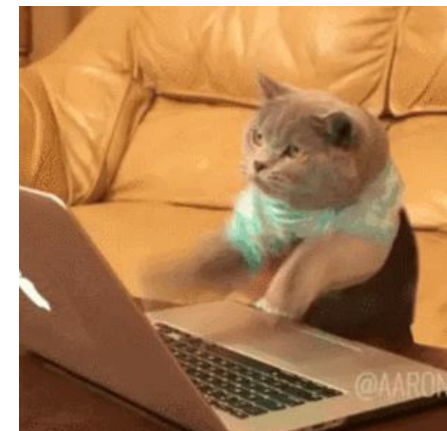


CHAPTER TEAM

Introduction

- Why is ESG reviewing the Honor Code?
 - Number of Honor Code violations has increased in recent years
- Why are we here today?
 - To get your input!

HONOR CODE REVISION

ESG Survey Results*: Exam related questions

- 25% of respondents have witnessed cheating during an exam
- 7% of respondents admit to cheating on an exam
- Of the students who chose NOT to report a violation on the Honor Code, the most common reasons were:
 - The violation did not affect me personally (42% of respondents)
 - It was not a major violation (28% of respondents)
 - The person was a friend/acquaintance (22% of respondents)

HONOR CODE REVISION

ESG Survey Results*: Homework/project related questions

- 75% of respondents have witnessed cheating on homework, projects, etc.
- 39% of respondents admit to cheating on homework, projects, etc.
- Of the students who chose NOT to report a violation on the Honor Code, the most common reasons were:
 - It was not a major violation (47% of respondents)
 - I do not think the act should be a violation (43% of respondents)
 - The person was a friend/acquaintance (22% of respondents)

HONOR CODE REVISION

Possible Points for Discussion

- Proctored Exams
- Honor Council or its Processes
- Every Other Seat for Exams
 - Room scheduling is increasingly strained with increasing enrollment
- Obligation to Report Violations
- Standard Syllabus Language
- Consistent Rules Across Courses

Electee Game: Minute to Win IT

M2WI: MARSHMALLOW TOWER



How to Play:

- 1 bag of large marshmallows
- Entire Electee Team
- Tallest tower after 1 minute wins!
- Hint: Try licking

M2WI: MARSHMALLOW TOSS

How to Play:

- 1/2 bag of small marshmallows
- 2 people from each Electee Team
- 10 feet apart
- Most marshmallows after 1 minute WINS

M2WI: STACK CUP

How to Play:

- 10 cups, 1 ping-pong ball
- Entire Electee Team
- Initial Set Up: Spread out all 10 cups
- 1 person starts with 1 cup and ball
 - Bounce ball into cup
 - Stack into 1 of spread out cups
 - Pass to next person
- First to bounce into full stack (or largest stack after 1.5 min) WINS

M2WI: FLIP CUP

How to Play:

- 5 cups
- 5 people from each Electee Team
- Flip cup from right-side up onto lid
- First to finish WINS
