








The American Death Triangle and the Sliding X. Which is which? Which is better? What is better than both?






Note the small angle between biners, equalization, isolation with knot in cordelette


ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER

ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER



Points

Interrupt:

- Point of order
 - The chair is doing something procedurally wrong
- Point of personal privilege
 - Text on the screen is too small, Speaker is too quiet

Speak before others waiting:

- Point of information
 - Factual question, Current state of debate
- Point of parliamentary inquiry
 - Would an amendment be in order? What magic words should I say?

TBP Voting Rules



Who can vote?

Active membership: undergrads + grads + alumni, all of whom have met active requirements either this semester or last semester

National dues changes + election of candidates: students only





Amendment to MI-G Bylaws

SECTION VIII.1. ACHIEVING ACTIVE STATUS

To achieve active status for the current semester, a Michigan Gamma Tau Beta Pi member must satisfy one of the following:

- (a) Be an officer, Distinguished Active, or Prestigious Active,
- (b) Have initiated into the society in the current semester, or,
- (c) Achieve a sufficient level of activity in the society, as defined by the following requirements:
- (i) Attend, at a minimum, two meetings, both of which must be voting meetings (2nd Actives, 3rd Actives or Officer Elections),
 - (ii) Complete two hours of TBP-sponsored service, and
 - (iii) Attend at least one social event.



Amendment to MI-G Bylaws

SECTION VIII.1. ACHIEVING ACTIVE STATUS (cont'd)


Members who have completed all requirements for active status apart from attendance at voting meetings may be considered a Temporary Active if sufficient voting meetings remain for the member to achieve active status for that semester. Temporary Active status is only maintained through the duration of voting meeting for which it is granted. In addition, any alumni member must request active status each semester, in accordance with C-VI of the Constitution of the Tau Beta Pi Association.



Amendment to MI-G Bylaws

SECTION VIII.3. TRACKING STATUS

Active status is evaluated by the Membership Officer. If an inactive member satisfies the above requirement mid-semester, he/she can also be made active immediately upon request. Where circumstances merit, the Membership Officer may choose to allow any member to substitute one form of requirement for another, provided that the total number of hours completed is not diminished as a result of this. Substitution for voting meetings should be allowed only under extenuating circumstances.



Recommendation of Eligible Candidates to Third Actives



MI-G Bylaw IV.1(g):

"The first meeting ("Second Actives") focuses on the character of the candidates for membership and must be held following the character interviews described in Appendix A or B as appropriate. In a closed session, the active members hold a discussion and vote on each prospective new member's character, the outcome of which must be reported to the candidates and to the second election of candidates meeting, as a recommendation on how to consider the character of those assessed. Those candidates recommended by the Vice President or the Graduate Student Vice President may be considered as a group. Active members will be given the opportunity to remove any questionable candidates from the group. All questionable or not-recommended candidates must be voted on individually. To be recommended for election, a candidate must receive a three-fourths (3/4) vote of the active membership present at the meeting. Active members, whether undergraduate or graduate students, are eligible to vote on new members."
