# BANQUET

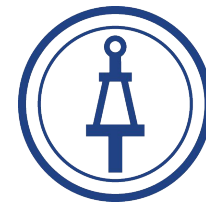
The Semesterly Banquet is a celebration of the accomplishments of the chapter and its members from across the semester

# QUORUM CHECK

- We will be conducting *routine business*. The TBP Association defines quorum for such businesses as  $\frac{1}{2}$  of active members
- I'm an electee, I don't count towards quorum? Correct! But you still get to vote :)
- What if we fail to make quorum?
  - **Bylaw 1.2(a):** The Advisory Board may deactivate any member as specified in the *Tau Beta Pi Association Bylaws Section 6.06*; criteria include non-attendance at that meeting. Unless otherwise specified by the Advisory Board, members so deactivated are automatically reactivated at the end of the meeting, or upon entering the meeting.
  - Must report it to the Association (doesn't look good)
- Thanks for being here — please stay!

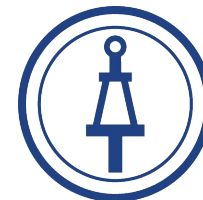

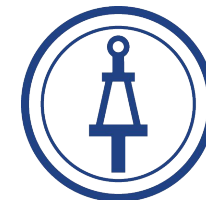

# ELECTION ORDER

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Grad Vice President
4. Secretary
5. Any other officers
  - Team Leads must be voted on before officers on that team
  - . \*\*\* Advisors can be elected at any time.
  - . \*\*\* Incoming and Outgoing Presidents may not participate in discussion of candidates, except for Advisors.
  - . \*\*\* Incoming Team Leads may not participate in discussion of officers on their team

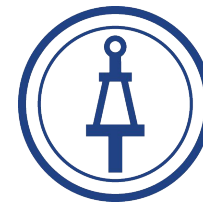

# VOTING

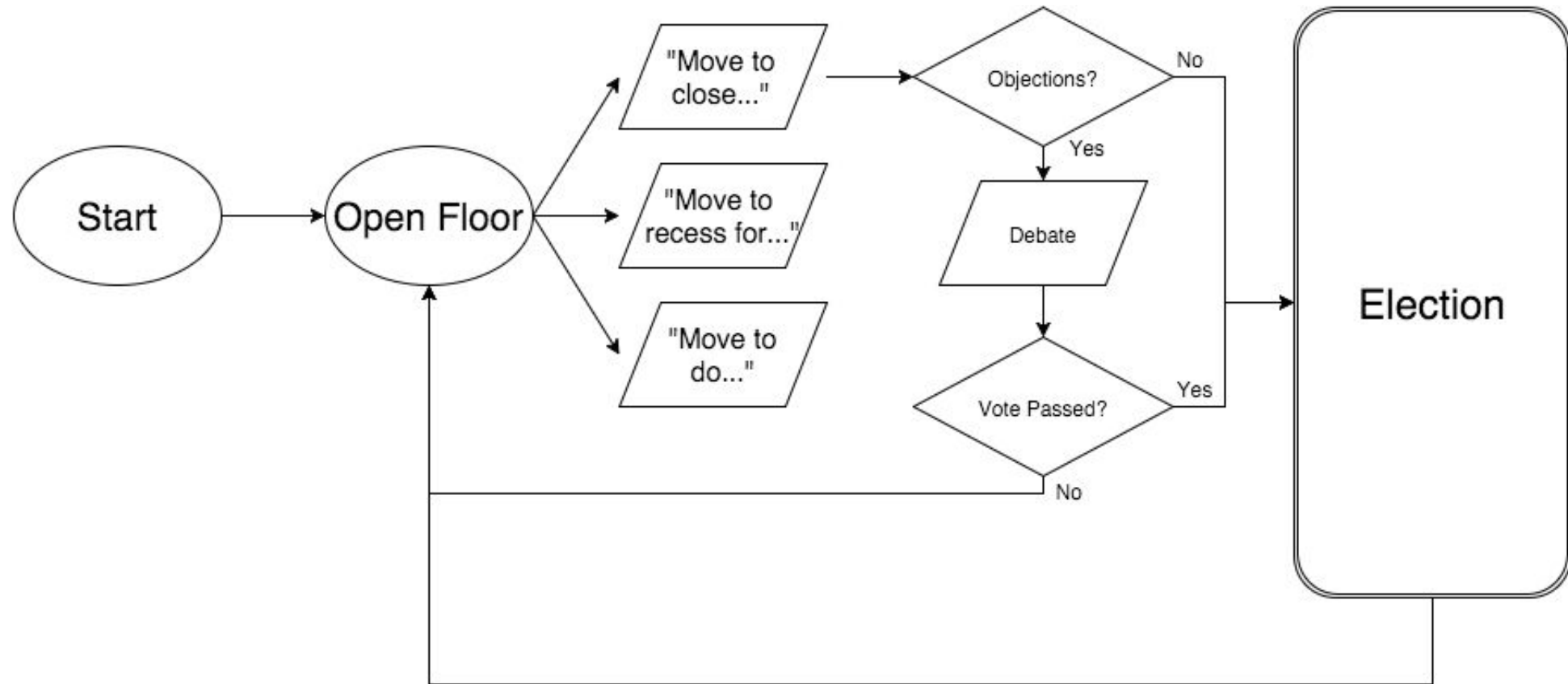
- To win an election:
  - For advisor, must receive a majority of the votes
  - For all other positions, must receive a plurality of the votes
  - Failure to do so is a vote of no-confidence
- Voice Votes
  - Uncontested elections will be voted on as a block

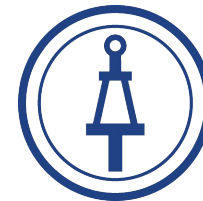

# GENERAL FLOW

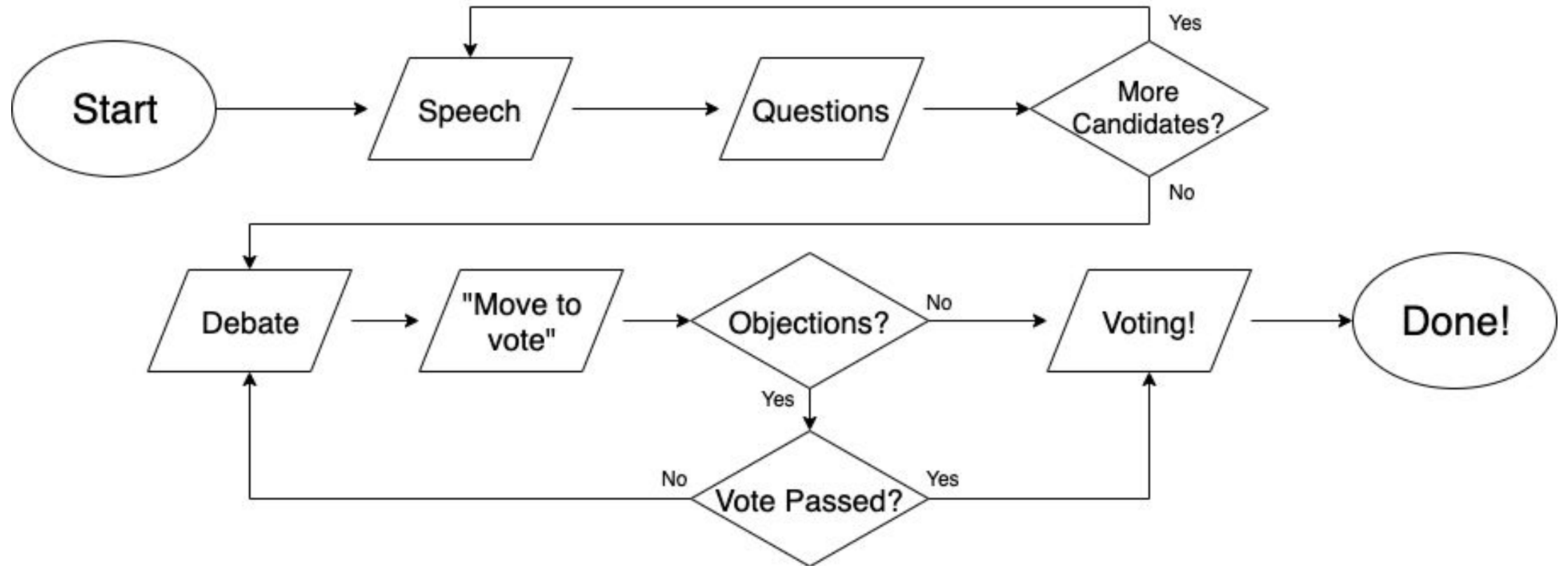

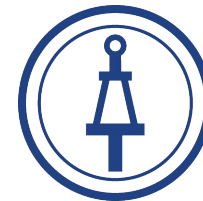

# ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER

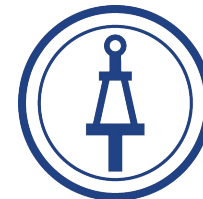
- Interrupt:

- Point of order
  - The chair is doing something procedurally wrong
- Point of personal privilege
  - Text on the screen is too small, speaker is too quiet

- Speak before others waiting:

- Point of information
  - Factual question, current state of debate
- Point of parliamentary inquiry
  - Would an amendment be in order? What magic words should I say?

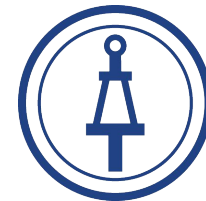

# ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER

- A member must be recognized by the chair before speaking
- Each member may speak twice per motion, with a limit of 10 minutes per speech (unless the group has adopted different rules)
- Remarks must be confined to the motion under discussion
- Discussion on candidates should be limited to matters pertaining to an individual's ability to successfully carry out the responsibilities of the office

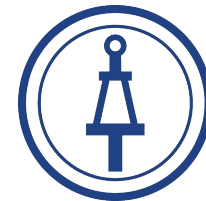

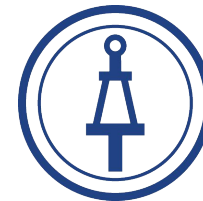

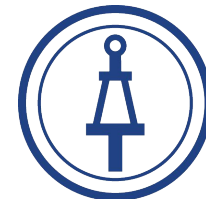

# THE CHAPTER ADVISORY BOARD

“7 Voting Members” (HQ actions & certain chapter actions)

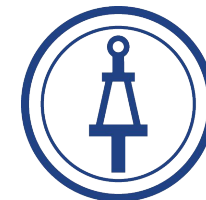
- President
- Vice President
- Secretary
- Chief Advisor
- 3 advisors (seniormost within current term, capped at 6 semesters)
- Most votes require 5/7
  - Officers/advisors cannot push anything through without support from the other

Additional non-voting members (most chapter-level decisions/procedural issues)

- Rest of the advisors

Non-voting members

- Treasurer
- Graduate Student Vice President
- External Vice Presidents

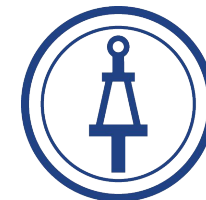

# THE CHAPTER ADVISORY BOARD

## Responsibilities

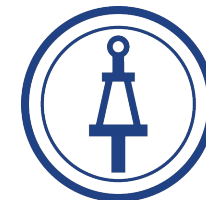
- Legal officers of the chapter (“7 voting members”)
  - This is not legal advice
  - I am not your lawyer
  - Fiduciary duty
  - Personally liable for events held by the chapter (see also: fraternal organization lawsuits)
- Advisory & judicial committee for the chapter
  - May forbid any chapter action by majority vote (4/7)
  - Appealable only to the HQ Executive Council (under the Association constitution)
- Approval/denial of any change to chapter constitution/bylaws (5/7 vote)
- Execution of Association procedures
  - Nominating/blocking academic programs for chapter eligibility
  - Handling objections to the candidate requirements (service hours, etc)
  - Voting to “continue” a candidate’s academic eligibility to the following semester, to give them another chance to meet the chapter’s requirements
  - Approving initiation fee loans
  - Designating otherwise active members as inactive

# WHAT IS THE ROLE OF AN ADVISOR

- Provide support
  - Serve as “leadership of last resort”
  - Educate officers about resources (UM, district, HQ, etc)
  - Be a liaison between chapter and HQ/district
  - Attend district meetings/Convention routinely to stay informed
  - Advocate for student views to UM/CoE/HQ/etc administrations
- Mentor
  - Provide continuity and institutional memory for long-running projects
  - Be involved in areas of the chapter according to interests/needs
  - Ensure core requirements are being met
    - Example: electing candidates, reporting to HQ
- Develop leadership
  - Provide constructive feedback to officers
  - Facilitate transition activities
  - Promote TBP programs (HQ & chapter) to the chapter

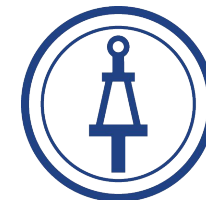
