ELECTING REQUIREMENTS

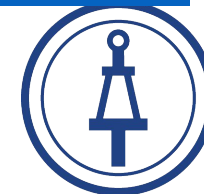
- EVERYTHING IS DUE BY EOD FRIDAY!!! (unless you have reached out to Aidan or Lexie)

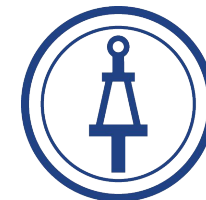

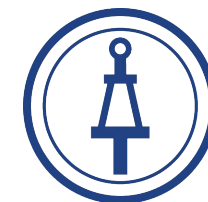

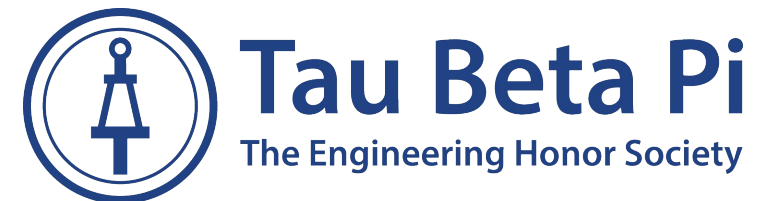
BANQUET

- If you are interested in joining the waitlist or if you can no longer attend, please slack Jaccob Bell

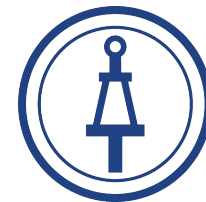

ACTIVE STATUS

- Next semester (F26), you will be considered Active Members
- Your new privileges include:
 - Count towards quorum at voting meetings (incl. Elections)
 - Ability to attend and vote at Actives Meetings (3)
 - Make decisions on chapter policies and bylaws
 - *Vote on the election of candidates*
 - Conduct candidate interviews
 - Consideration for attending National Convention (Fall) and District Conference (Winter)
