

How to deliver bad news to your PI

1. Never admit guilt.  
**Wrong:** I sucked up all the cells while aspirating the media from the petri dish.  
**Correct:** The cells seemed really sparse when I checked under the microscope. I think some of them detached from the petri dish.
2. Rely heavily on the adjective "wonky."  
Examples:  
"The **gelatin** looked a bit **wonky**."  
"The **microscope** was being really **wonky**."  
"The **cells** were behaving kinda **wonky**."  
**Can be applied to reagents, equipment, and biological materials!**
3. Suggest at least two solutions of your own before your PI dreams up their own solution, which will probably take multiple 10-hour days in lab.

# Membership in Tau Beta Pi

---



## Eligibility requirements:

- Distinguished Scholarship
  - Assessed by GPA - top  $\frac{1}{8}$  of junior class or top  $\frac{1}{5}$  of senior class
- Exemplary Character
  - Assessed with a character interview and questionnaire

# Requirements



- Attendance at **all (5) General meetings, Elections, and Initiation**
  - Electees with valid conflicts may use additional service hours to fill this requirement
- Completion of **16 total hours of service**
- Attendance of **4 PD/Social Events**
- Attendance at least **two meetings of your Electee Team and two meetings with other members in TBPals**
- Character evaluation process
  - Electees questionnaire
  - Character Interviews
- Peer Interviews
- Electee Exam
- \$100 Dues



# Requirement: Service

---



- Completion of **16 total hours of service**
  - 1 hour Tutoring
  - 3 hours of K-12 Outreach events



# Requirement: Social & Prof. Dev.

---



- Attendance of **4 PD/Social Events**
- A minimum of **1 social event** is required for initiation
  - These are fun, most of the time free food is provided!
  - In the past, these have included:
    - Game nights
    - TGs at BWW i.e. Free wings at Buffalo Wild Wings
    - Intramural Sports teams
- A minimum of **1 professional development event** is also required
  - In the past, these have included:
    - TBP sponsored Corporate Information Sessions
    - TBP sponsored Professional Headshots
    - Interview and resume workshops



# Requirement: Electee Team Activities

---

# Requirement: Paperwork & Dues

  - Exam is in your blue folder already! Also available online

- Completion of **6 Casual Peer Interviews** by New Initiatives III
