

#### **Quick Icebreaker**


#### Picnic Game!



- We are going on a picnic together, each person is bringing something that starts with the same letter as your name
- Each person will introduce themselves with their item, ie.
  - 1st person: I'm Jack and I'm bringing Jello

#### How to play:

- Everyone has a stack of paper
  - # of papers = # of team members
- First person writes a phrase or sentence
  - Passes paper to left
- Second person reads, then draws phrase on NEW paper
  - Passes drawing to left
- Third person sees drawing, writes a phrase on NEW paper to describe
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Passes to left, on and on
- Stop once you receive one of your own papers
