



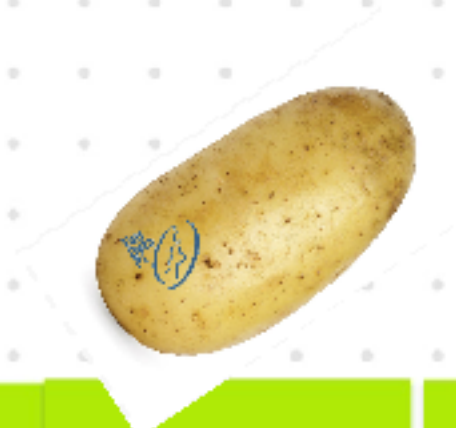

Events catered towards grad students, not just normal events restricted to grad students

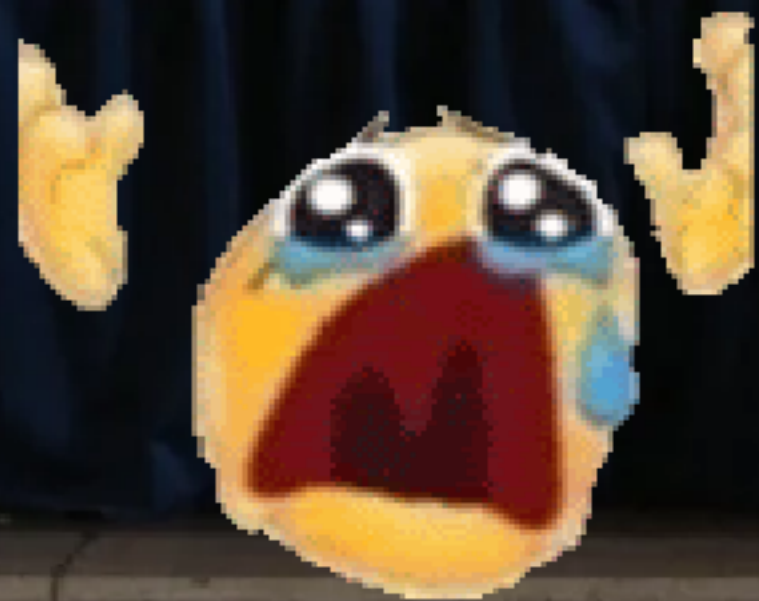
Better TBPals system
