
## Initiation Requirements

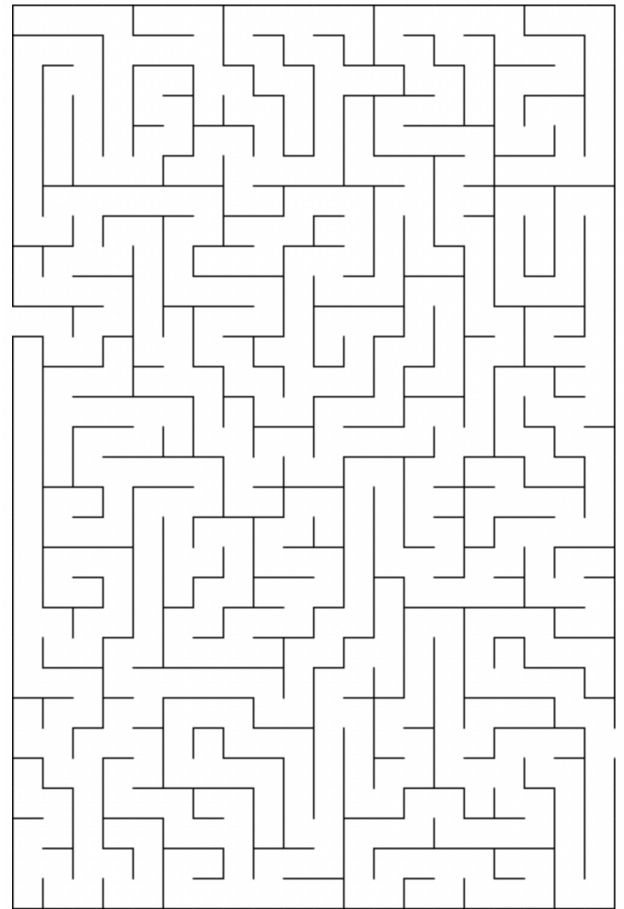

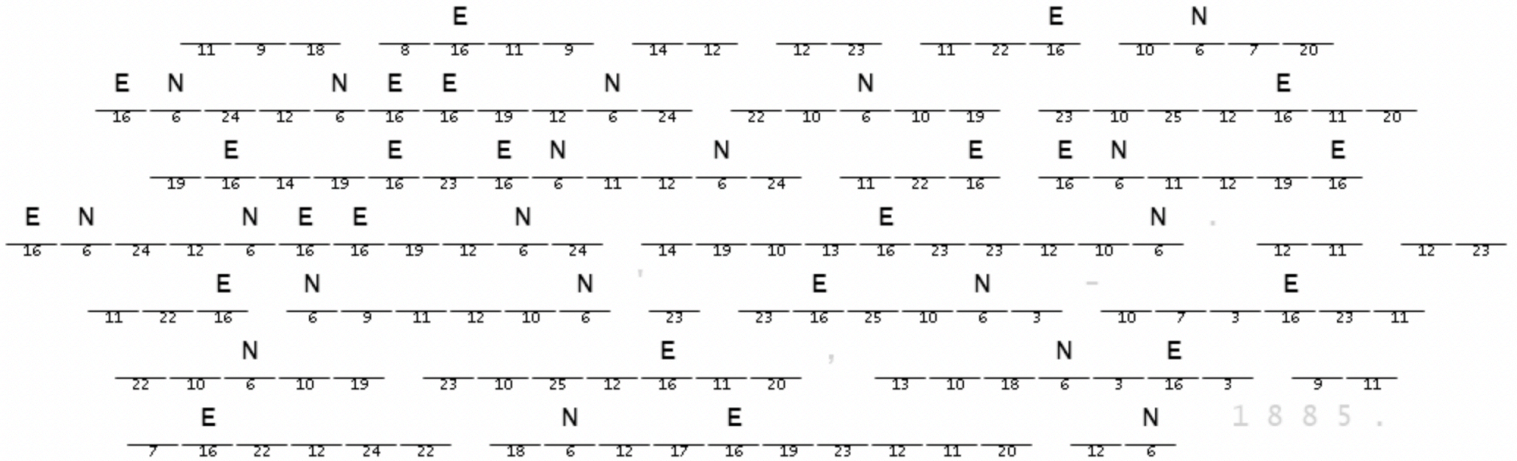
