You know what game is totally similar to Kahoot? Jeopardy! So here are some fun facts about Jeopardy! I totally didn't write this section thinking that you guys were playing Jeopardy for your electee team game today.

The iconic Jeopardy theme song, *Think!*, was originally a lullaby Merv Griffin, the creator of Jeopardy, wrote for his son. However, *Think!* wasn't used as the show's theme



song until 1978. From the show's creation in 1964 until 1975, the jazz tune *Take Ten*, composed by Julann Wright, was used as the main theme and *Think!* was used exclusively as the countdown music for final Jeopardy.

Although Ken Jennings is now mostly known as the host of Jeopardy who took after the late Alex Trebek, he was a legendary Jeopardy player in his own right. Ken Jennings holds the longest winning streak in Jeopardy history at 74 games which has garnered him \$2,520,700 in winnings. This is 34 games more than the second longest winning streak held by Amy Schneider at 40 games.
