TBP Acronym: Tau Beta Pi

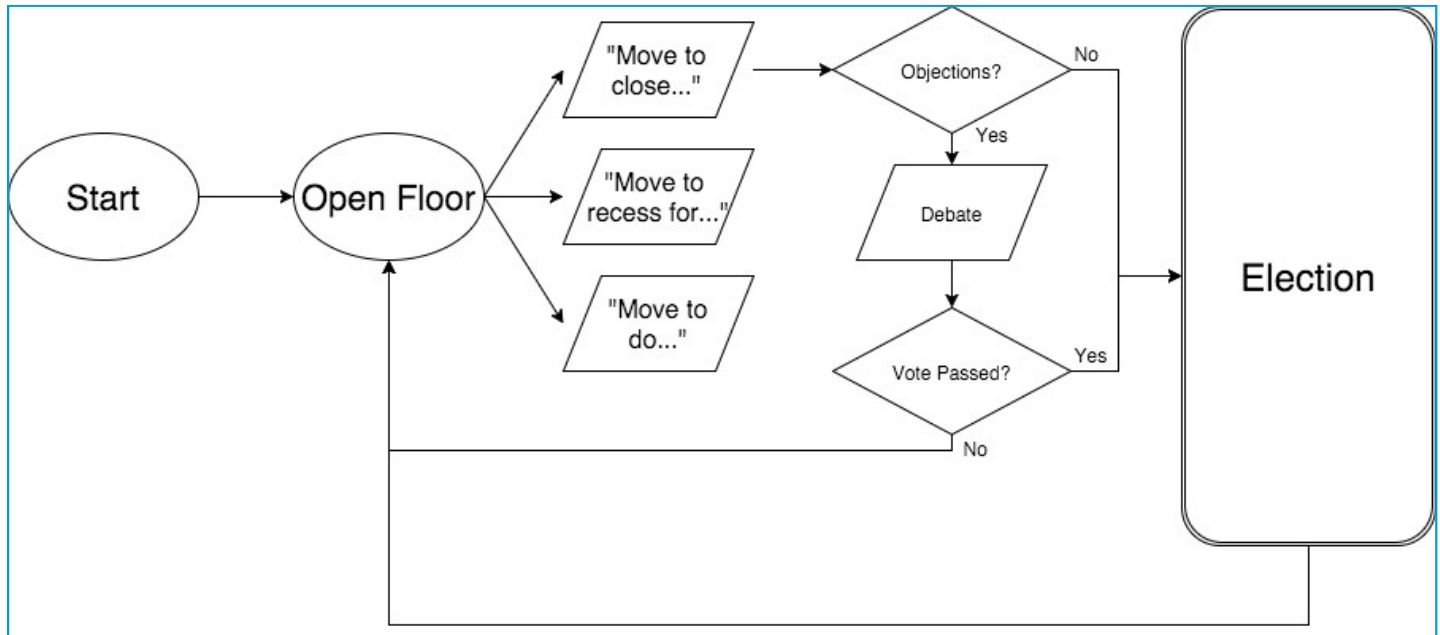
Why he's awesome: Stepped up and helped out at The Breakfast Party when there weren't enough volunteers and provided enthusiastic service when it was needed most.



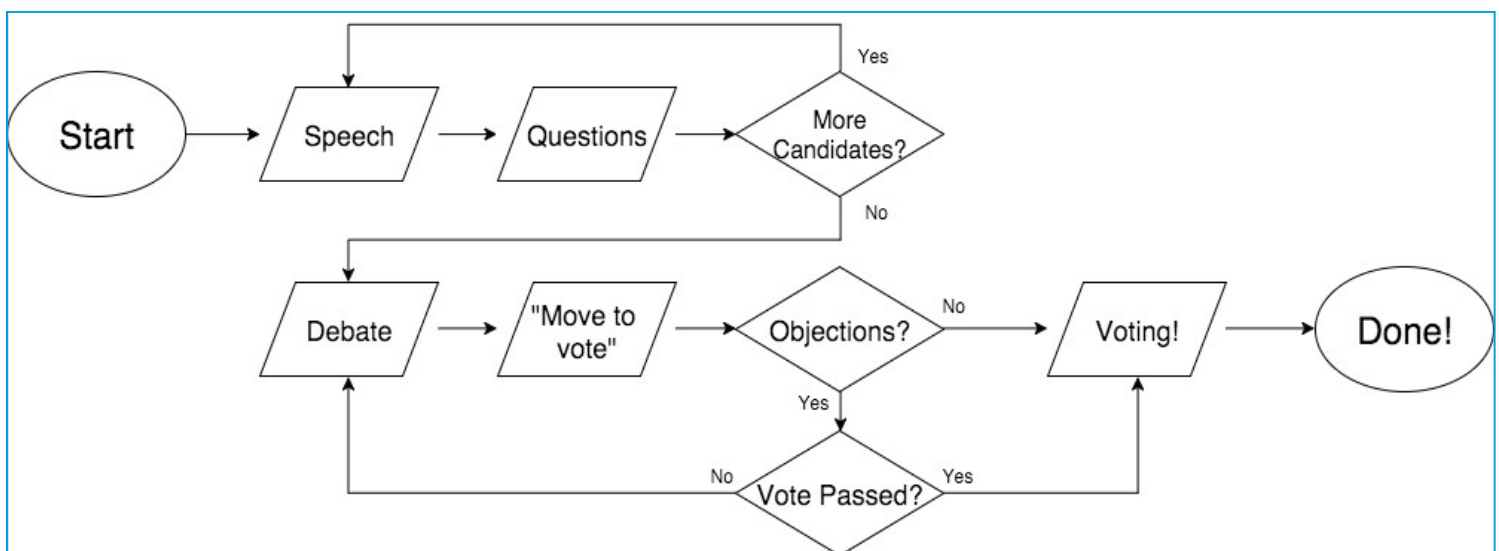
Robert's Rules

Elections Flow:



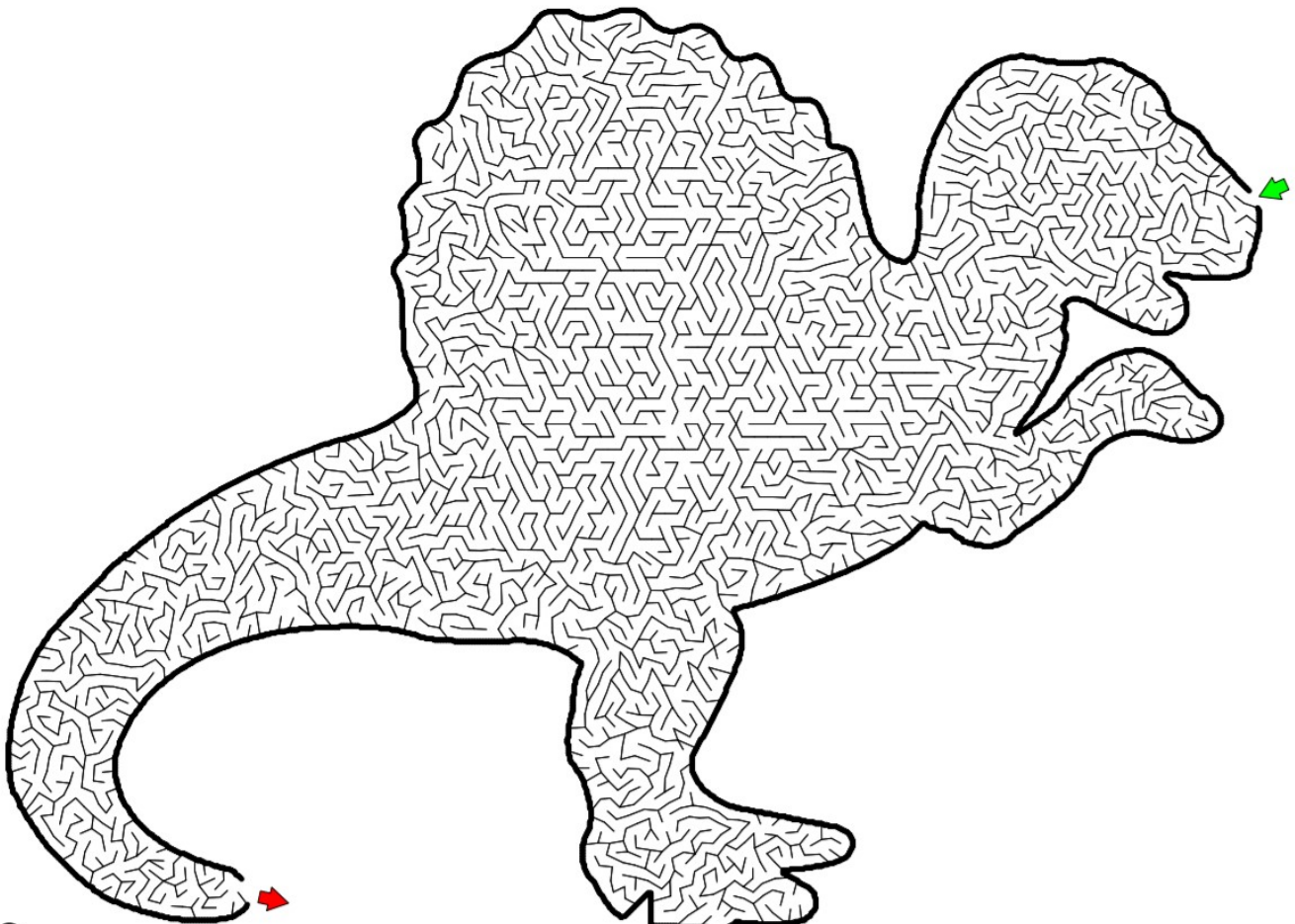
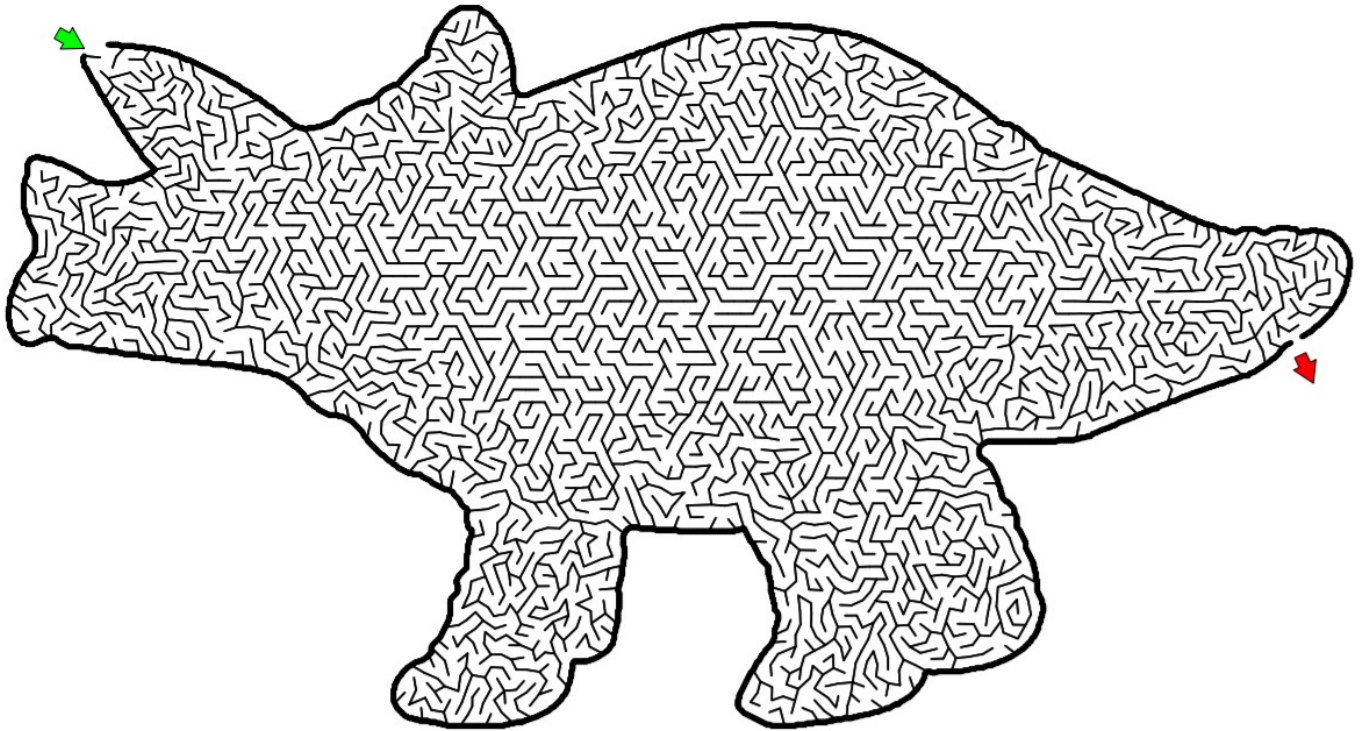
Officer Election:
